Purpose and legal basis of data processing:

To exercise householder's rights and to protect its legitimate interests according to § 6 DSGVO (GDPR)

Legitimate interests pursued:

Protection against criminal offences, access control and investigation of crimes

Storage period or criteria for determining such period:

28 days according to factory agreement "CCTV Surveillance System"

References to the rights of those concerned

The person concerned shall be entitled to obtain information by the responsible persons as to whether or not they will process personal data related to him or her; if this is the case, he or she shall have the **right to obtain information about** such personal data and all related information specified in article 15 of the German General Data Protection Regulation DSGVO.

The person concerned shall have the right to promptly require from the responsible persons **rectification** of any inaccurate personal data relating to him or her and to **complete** any incomplete personal data, if applicable (article 16 DSGVO).

The person concerned shall have the right to request from the responsible persons that any personal data relating to him or her be immediately deleted if one of the reasons set out in detail in article 17 DSGVO applies, e.g. if such data is no longer needed for the interests pursued (**right to delete data**).

The person concerned shall have the right to request from the responsible persons **restriction of data processing** if one of the conditions mentioned in article 18 DSGVO applies, e.g. if the person concerned brought its opposition against such processing, but only for the duration of the examination of an appeal carried out by a responsible person.

The person concerned shall have the right, on compelling legitimate grounds relating to his or her particular situation, to **object** to the processing of personal data relating to him or her at any time. The responsible persons will no longer process such personal data unless they are able to provide compelling and legitimate reasons for further processing such data that will prevail over the need to protect the interests, rights and freedoms of the person concerned, or the processing of such data is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims (article 21 DSGVO).

Every person concerned shall have the **right to lodge a complaint** with a supervisory authority, without prejudice to any other administrative appeal or judicial remedies, if the person concerned is of the opinion that processing of personal data relating to him or her violates any of the provisions set out in the German General Data Protection Regulation GDPR (article 77 DSGVO). The person concerned may exercise this right before any supervisory authority in the member state where he or she is resident, where his or her place of work is or where the alleged infringement was committed.
